- ❖ Students were given the chance to meet different clubs on campus all at one event.



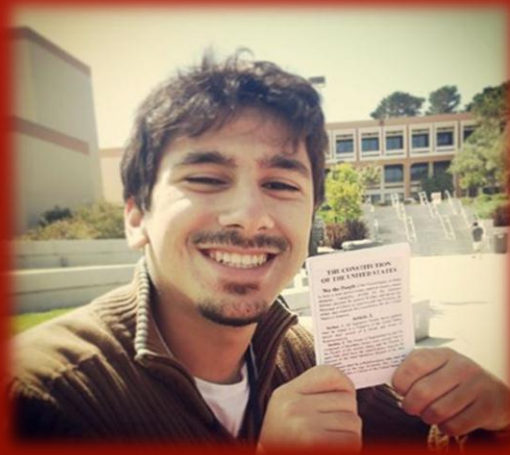
