In the following emergencies, immediate care is crucial. Call 9-911. Notify the Health Center x4270 and Security x4199. Have someone else call if possible.

- Severe burns
- Uncontrolled bleeding
- Suspected fracture of neck or back
- Suspected poisoning
- Severe chest pain ... suspected heart attack
- Respiratory distress or cessation of breathing
- Prolonged unconsciousness

## If the person is not breathing:

- 1. Flip to section on HEART ATTACK / STOPPAGE OF BREATHING. Start rescue breathing immediately.
- 2. The first 4 minutes are critical! Have someone call 9-911. State why you are calling and your location. Do not hang up until the emergency dispatcher hangs up.
- 3. Ask someone to notify the Health Center and Campus Security.
