The Skyline College *Administration of Justice Program* endeavors to facilitate close and continuous collaboration with experts in the field of criminal justice and law enforcement in our local service area to improve the program and its services, and to help prepare students for employment in criminal justice.

One of the ways we accomplish this is by regularly meeting with local criminal justice professionals who work in San Mateo County, such as police chiefs and sheriffs, police commanders, training and recruitment managers, and members of the courts, such as district attorneys, and other professionals. The name of this group is the **San Mateo County Law Enforcement training Managers Association (SMCoTMA)**.

Faculty members of the Skyline College ADMJ Program regularly attend SMCoTMA monthly meetings that are well attended by a broad spectrum of such professionals. ADMJ faculty, from our college and from the College of San Mateo, engage in open dialogue with our professional counterparts in the criminal justice field on a regular basis. We are able to bring information and concerns about our program to the group as well as bring back information that would be helpful to our program. Thus, the SMCoTMA, including Skyline College ADMJ faculty members, has been a valuable resource and has served as our “Advisory Committee” on a monthly basis.
