



WHAT ARE YOUR OPTIONS?

There are four ways to get closed captions to your YouTube videos

1. Use Youtube's Automatic Captioning feature

(Note: depending on the sound quality and language, it can take 30 minutes - a couple of hours for the automatic captioning feature to appear. Sometimes automatic captioning may not appear at all. Give at least 24 hours.)

- 2. Manual YouTube Captioning
- 3. Insert a Transcript/ Insert your own closed caption file (.SRT, .SRI)
- 4. Transcribe & Auto-sync

Tips Before you upload!

Closed captions are captions that are embedded into the video and cannot be seen unless turned on.

Open captions are always visible and cannot be turned off. They are burned directly into the video and are a part of the picture. Allows you to upload your videos directly into your LMS.
