Spring 2018 textbook cost savings of **\$202,701.63**

- 34 faculty participants
- 55 ZTC or OER course sections offered
- 1543 students impacted

Summer 2018 textbook costs of **\$107,875.79**

- 18 unique faculty participants
- 30 ZTC or OER course sections that impacted
- 846 students over an eight-week session
