Crestmoor Neighborhood Memorial Scholarship

Launched in 2016 Dual Goals:

- Honor the community members who most directly endured the destruction of the explosion and fire
- Help outstanding San Bruno students realize their dream of attending college

Scholarship Awards

- For community college students transferring to a four-year college or university:
 - \$10,000 (\$5,000 per year for up to two years)
- Total of \$190,000 to be awarded in 2021



Scholarship Awards

Scholarship awards may be used for:

- Tuition and fees
- Books and required supplies
- Room and board
- Transportation
- Renewal of the Scholarship is contingent upon:
 - Proof of full-time enrollment for the following academic year
 - Proof of status as a student in good standing at the college (not on academic/progress probation (for 2 consecutive semesters) or on dismissal)



Applicant Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Live in San Bruno or attend a community college located in San Bruno at the time of application
- Plan to enroll, during the fall of 2021, as a transfer student at an accredited four-year college
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act Application



Criteria

Must demonstrate:

 Deep engagement and involvement in the San Bruno community (<u>Student Bios</u>)

Other factors considered:

- Applicant's financial need
- Extracurricular activities
- Academic record
- Examples of leadership, teamwork, and collaboration
- Significant challenges or obstacles you have faced and how that has affected your school and community involvement OR significant achievements not highlighted elsewhere in application

Beginning in June	 Payment of awards upon proof of enrollment
June 2	 Foundation Scholarship Presentation (mandatory for winners)
