Requirements:

Applicants...

- 1. Must be of Latino background
- 2. Must have a minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA (submit unofficial high school or college transcripts)
- 3. Must be a high school senior going to college OR a community college student transferring to a four-year college or university next fall
- 4. Must attach a personal statement essay (no longer than 2 pages) addressing the following prompt questions: What does being Latino/a mean to you? What college or university are you planning to attend next fall and how will this scholarship help you reach your academic and career goals? In the future, how do you plan to give back to your community?
- 5. Must complete the following social media steps:

 - b.
