

GUARANTEED TRANSFER PROGRAMS

Many universities offer programs that guarantee transfer admission for Skyline College students up to one year in advance of your transfer date. Most guaranteed transfer programs are based on your college record, not your high school record. Even if you did not qualify for the university upon your high school graduation, you can still transfer if you complete requirements at Skyline.

Note: Students should consult with a Skyline counselor to ensure all requirements are met by calling the Counseling Office at (650) 738-4317

GUARANTEED TRANSFER PROGRAMS TO UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (UC) CAMPUSES

UC DAVIS

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

You qualify for guaranteed admission if you:

- Have 30 UC transferable units completed at the time the TAG is written (one year prior to transfer)
- Have a 2.9 GPA for most majors (Note: Some majors require a higher GPA and/or completion of major courses)
- Will transfer as a junior with at least 60 UC transferable units completed before you begin your studies at UCD and will have completed all necessary admission requirements.
- Will be enrolled full-time during your last two semester at Skyline College

TAG's are available for Fall 2010 only.

TAG must be written one year prior to transfer

Deadlines: September 30th, 2009

UC IRVINE

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

You may be eligible for a TAG if you:

- Have completed the last 30 units at a CC;
- Have at least a 3.0 GPA in all UC transferable coursework;
- Completed a transferable math course and the 1st transferable English course (with grades of "C" or better) by the end of Summer 2009
- Will complete 60 UC transferable units by the end of Spring 2010
- Will complete all additional requirements for the major, including GPA prior to enrollment at UCI.

Students apply for a UCI TAG via the online TAG Checklist process at uctransfer.org. The submission date is September 1st – October 15th.

UCLA

Transfer Alliance Program (TAP)

Open only to students in the Skyline College Honors Transfer Program. Students who meet program requirements are given priority consideration for admission as juniors to the College of Letters and Science at UCLA (except for the Communications major.) UC MERCED

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

In order to apply for a TAG, you need to:

- have completed 27 UC transferable units and have a 2.7 GPA at the time you submit the TAG form (some majors require a higher GPA and/or completion of major courses);
- for some majors, complete all of the major preparation listed on assist.org prior to enrolling in the university. UC Merced offers TAG'S for Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 TAG Filing Period: September 1 – November 30 (Fall) May 1 – July 31 (Spring)

UC RIVERSIDE

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

You qualify for guaranteed transfer if you:

- have a 2.8 GPA for most majors (Note: Some majors require a higher GPA and/or completion of major courses)
- Will transfer as a junior with at least 60 UC transferable units completed before you begin your studies at UCR and will have completed all necessary admission requirements
- Complete a contract with UCR that specifies the requirements that you must satisfy for admission. Admission is not guaranteed to majors in Engineering, Business Administration or Art (Studio). TAG's are available for Fall, Winter and Spring quarters. Deadlines: TAG must be completed before you submit your UC application.

UC SANTA BARBARA

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

TAG's are available for nearly all majors at UCSB except performing arts majors in the College of Letters and Science and majors in the College of Creative Studies. TAG's are being offered for majors under the College of Engineering.

You qualify for guaranteed transfer if you:

- Earn a 3.0 GPA in all UC-transferable coursework completed by the end of Fall 2009 (Note: Some majors require a higher GPA and/or completion of major courses)
- Will complete at least 60 UC transferable units by the end of the Spring semester prior to transfer
- Will complete required courses in English composition and Math *by the end of the Fall semester* prior to transfer

Additional criteria apply. Please consult with your Skyline College counselor.

TAG's are written one year prior to transfer. TAG's are available for Fall 2010 semester only.

UC SANTA CRUZ

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

You qualify for guaranteed transfer if you have:

- 30 UC transferable units completed at the time
- Have fewer than 20 semester units (30 quarter units) completed at a four-year institution
- Have at least a 3.0 GPA in all UC-transferable course work
- Be enrolled at a participating California Community College
- 3.0 GPA for most majors (Note: Some majors require a higher GPA and/or completion of major courses)
- Will transfer as a junior with at least 60 UC transferable units completed before you begin your studies at UCSC and will have completed all necessary admission requirements

TAG's are available for Fall admission only.

TAG Filing Period: Aug. 1 – Oct 15, 2009

UC San Diego

Transfer Admissions Guarantee (TAG)

You qualify for a TAG if you:

- Have completed 30 UC transferable units at the time of application
- Will have completed 60 UC transfer units by the end of Spring 2010 (for Fall 2010 admissions) and Summer 2010 (for Winter 2011 admissions)
- Earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in all UC transferable coursework completed
- Meet screening criteria for designated majors requiring lower-division preparation prior to admission into the major.

- **Fall 2009 applicants:** Students need to earn a cumulative 3.0 minimum UC GPA and complete the two required UC transferable English courses and one UC transferable Math by the end of Fall term 2009, maintain a 3.00 GPA through the end of Spring 2010, and complete IGETC by Spring 2010.
- **Winter 2011 applicants:** Students need to earn a cumulative 3.00 UC GPA through the end of summer 2010, complete both the two UC transferable English courses and a UC transferable Math course by Summer 2010, and complete IGETC by Summer 2010.

GUARANTEED ADMISSION TO CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY (CSU) CAMPUSES

If you meet minimum eligibility requirements, you are guaranteed to transfer to any CSU with the exception of impacted majors or campuses. For information on impacted majors and campuses, see CSUMentor (www.csumentor.org). For information on minimum eligibility requirements, schedule an appointment with a counselor by calling the Counseling Office at (650) 738-4317.

CAL STATE EAST BAY (Formerly CSU Hayward) Transfer Admission Agreement Program (TAG)

You qualify for guaranteed transfer and waiver of application fees if you:

- Have a minimum of 12 CSU transferable units completed at the time the contract is written
- Will transfer as a junior with at least 60 transferable units with a 2.0 GPA, including 30 units of General Education coursework completed with "C" grades or better
- Will complete a course in each of the following areas with "C" grades or better: oral communication, written communication, critical thinking, and quantitative reasoning

Qualified students will receive preadmission advising with a Cal State East Bay counselor. TAG agreement must be completed no later than one year prior to intended entry to Cal State East Bay. The TAG is available for all majors except Nursing and Business Administration.

PRIVATE COLLEGES

DEVRY UNIVERSITY

Transfer students are guaranteed admissions following completion of at least 12 college units with a grade of "C" or better and fulfillment of DeVry's English and Math entrance requirements. DeVry also provides transfer scholarships for students who have completed an AA or AS within the last year with a 3.2 cumulative GPA. GOLDEN GATE UNIVERSITY Transfer Admission Guarantee

Transfer students are guaranteed admission following completion of at least 24 units with a GPA of 2.0 and fulfillment of Golden Gate University's English Language Proficiency Requirement. GGU also provides transfer scholarships for students who have completed at least 24

units with a 2.75 GPA. For more information, contact the Transfer Center at (650) 738-4232.

MILLS COLLEGE HONORS AGREEMENT

Open only to female students in the Skyline College Honors Transfer Program. Students who meet honors requirements are given priority admission to Mills College. Students with 3.5 GPA or higher will also be guaranteed a renewable annual scholarship ranging from \$10,000 to \$12,500.

Mills also provides an opportunity for ANY qualified female Skyline student to participate in a cross-enrollment program. Students in this program will be allowed to enroll in one Mills College course per semester at no cost.

NOTRE DAME DE NAMUR UNIVERSITY TRANSFER AGREEMENT

Any student who successfully graduates with an AA or AS degree from Skyline College with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and is in good disciplinary standing is guaranteed admission to Notre Dame de Namur University.

This agreement is applicable to any student who has completed the application process at Notre Dame de Namur for either the Fall or Spring semester within one year of completing his or her degree at Skyline College.

What is a Transfer Admissions Guarantee (TAG)?

Transfer Admissions Guarantee (TAG) is a program that offers you guaranteed admissions to several colleges & universities (see the list below). The writing of a TAG contract enables **qualified** students to be guaranteed admissions one year prior to transfer. Students must meet certain requirements to be eligible for a TAG.

What are the requirements for writing a TAG?

If you have completed 30 transferrable units (for either the CSU and UC), have completed the required major course prerequisites, and have a 2.8 GPA (higher GPA required for some majors and colleges), you may be eligible to write a TAG contract.

When do I apply for a TAG?

Apply one year before you plan on transferring. For Fall 2010 TAG's, counselors will assist students with writing contracts September thru October 2009.

IMPORTANT: Each campus has its own TAG submission deadline. Check with the Transfer Center to determine the closing date for the campus of your choice.

What is the process of applying for a TAG?

Make an appointment with a TAG counselor by visiting the Skyline College Transfer Center, Building Two, Room 2227, or by calling (650) 738-4232.

What will I need to bring with me to my TAG appointment?

You will need to bring transcripts of all colleges attended (unofficial transcripts accepted), and if applicable, any AP or IB test scores.

HONORS TRANSFER PROGRAM & PHI THETA KAPPA STUDENTS
