"The Institutional Effectiveness Division recently formed under the State Chancellor's Office has established a technical assistance program whereby colleges can submit a Letter of Interest to receive assistance from a Partnership Resource Teams (PRT). These teams consist of peers from across the California Community College system who have expertise in specific areas of focus identified by collegesthrough this initiative, there is the availability of up to \$150,000 in grant funds that can support the College in addressing its areas of interest." (November 2015, "Skyline Shines") B. Last spring, Skyline College submitted a proposal and was granted \$150,000 to implement it. Skyline College will utilize the resources available through the IEPI to achieve the following: 1. To enhance the planning and resource allocation processes, adopt a technology-driven system with the ability to document, aggregate, and automate program/college-level plan components. 2.
