

Skyline College encourages staff and faculty participation in the decision-making process




Skyline College Employee Voice Survey – Spring 2018; summary of Agree/Strongly Agree responses

The participatory governance process provides me with adequate opportunities to provide input in the decision-making process at Skyline College.





Participatory Governance Types

- Committee a body of persons elected or delegated to consider, investigate, take action on, or report on some matter
 - e.g., AS, CS, ASSC; IEC & SPARC
- Task Force a limited-term, non-governance group
 - concrete task(s), "as needed"
 - e.g., Art on Campus committee
- Operational Work Group a non-governance group that carries out operational task.
 - Commencement Committee
