## Skyline College has seen a student headcount decline every year since 2013

Student Headcounts at SMCCCD Colleges


Fall 2018 to Fall 2019 Declines:

Skyline headcount is down 3.9\%
CSM headcount is down 10.7\%

Cañada headcount is down 2.7\%
Overall, the District is down 7.7\%

Until recently, CSMs enrollment decline had been tempered by growing international student enrollments.
