The Institutional Effectiveness Committee is charged with fostering a culture of inquiry through facilitating program review, analyzing the research that assesses how effectively the College is accomplishing its mission and goals, and broadly communicating the results so that the College has a shared understanding of its strengths and challenges so as to set appropriate priorities.

# 2021 – 2022 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

#### **1)** Created program review infrastructure

- Secured CGC approval of PR calendar
- Reviewed, approved, and implemented the Comprehensive Program Review (CPR) checklists pilot
- Crafted strategies to offer constructive, supportive feedback
- Established presentations and their parameters as culminating CPR experience
- Reflected on and proposed changes to CPR processes for next year

# 2021 – 2022 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

### 2) Implemented <u>CPR Task Force Recommendations</u>

- Supported first CPR cohort
- Piloted CPR Templates and Checklists
- Hosted CPR presentations, with about 35 guests for each meetingincluding administrators
- Gathered signatures of reporting dean, VP, and when applicable, Curriculum Committee Chair

# 2021 – 2022 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

3) Secured approval of <u>ACCJC Institutional Set Standards and</u> <u>Aspirational Goals</u> by the CGC

### 4) Updating Institutional Student Learning Outcomes (ISLOs)

- Approved changing ISLO assessment process to focus on one ISLO each year and engaging all degree bearing programs
- Approved piloting of creativity to all ISLOs
- Reviewed, updated and secured approval of Effective Communication ISLO by the CGC

## 2022 – 2023 GOALS

#### 1) Continue fleshing out and supporting program review processes

- Create and pilot a proposed approach to make the culminating CPR experience more dialogic than lecture based
- Support second cohort of programs undergoing comprehensive review
- Implement the Improvement Platform for program review

#### 2) Update ISLOs

- Review, update, and approve the Information Literacy and Lifelong Wellness ISLOs and rubrics in the Fall
- Tackle the Citizenship and possibly the Critical and Creative Thinking ISLOs in the spring

#### 3) Review college-wide metrics

- Review and recommend ACCJC Institutional Set Standards and Aspirational Goals
- Review the <u>Skyline College Scorecard</u>
