




Action Plan: Goals

Which is the goal for the Outreach Program?

- 1) Increase number of first-time Latinx students from feeder high schools who enroll at Skyline College
- 2) Engage prospective students through the Counselor Liaison Program
- 3) Provide on-site assistance at the high schools
- 4) Host the La Raza Youth Conference

Which is the goal for the Art Program?

- 1) Allocate time during department meetings to share and discuss successful online practices and tools and areas of challenge
- 2) Survey students in Art classes to gather input on their online experience and suggestions for improvement
- 3) Attain certification in the CTTL Quality Online Teaching and Learning (QOTL) Course
- 4) Increase online retention and student success

Which is the goal for the International Student Program?

- Provide orientation, New F-1 student orientation, Global Online Learning, and Counseling 101 via Canvas online courses
- 2) Maintain the retention of international students through COVID
- Create videos to help students access information that is pertinent to them as international students
- 4) Increase student engagement via Pronto and a discussion board

Which is the goal for the Mathematics Department?

- 1) Analyze first year transfer level math completion longitudinally
- 2) Create a ZTC hyflex Math 120 Intermediate Algebra curriculum using Canvas and Khan Academy
- 3) Create a B-STEM pathway that leads Science, Technology, & Health as well as Business, Entrepreneurship, & Management Meta Majors through calculus and into career success.
- 4) Form a community of practice in the hopes of scaling the adoption of the ZTC hyflex curriculum for Math 225

PR Goals, Implementation Steps, & Measures

CPR TERM	DEFINITION
Goal	A statement of intended outcomes or results
Implementation Steps	A plan of action over the next couple of years to achieve a goal, ideally including a timeline
Measure(s)	Specific targeted objectives which capture the impact on student learning, student achievement, and/or program effectiveness, and which can be integrated or separate from the goal statement

S.M.A.R.T. GOAL PLANNING



☐ Increase the percent of exiting CTE students who report being employed in their field of study.
☐ Reduce equity gaps across all of the above measures among traditionally underrepresented student groups.
☐ Provide students authentic applications of learning
☐ Connect students with relevant student/learning support services
