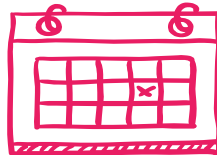
Community Engagement ISLO Revision Goals



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- Changed ISLO name to “Community Engagement” to move away from the notion of “Citizenship” and the language of “legality”
 - Unified disparate descriptors via an “Awareness, Action, Reflection” framework
 - Emphasized cultural “humility” rather than merely cultural “awareness”
 - Emphasized students’ sense of agency and responsibility as it relates to community engagement

Fall 2023 Community Engagement ISLO Timeline

- **Monday, 9/11:** Ask IEC to solicit feedback from constituents over the month of September (please share via email to ensure discussion/feedback by F. 10/6)
- **Friday, 10/6:** IEC reps discuss solicited feedback with constituents during October division meetings (if no division meeting, solicit feedback via email)
- **Monday, 10/9:** IEC reps share division feedback with IEC for discussion (no vote)
- **Tuesday, 10/10:** IEC ISLO Task Group shares revisions for further feedback (via email)
- **Monday, 10/23:** IEC votes to take Community Engagement ISLO to CGC (no discussion)
- **Wednesday, 10/25:** IEC ISLO Task Group visits CGC for final vote
