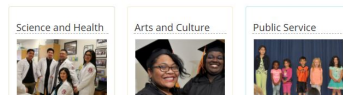
**Learning Communities**

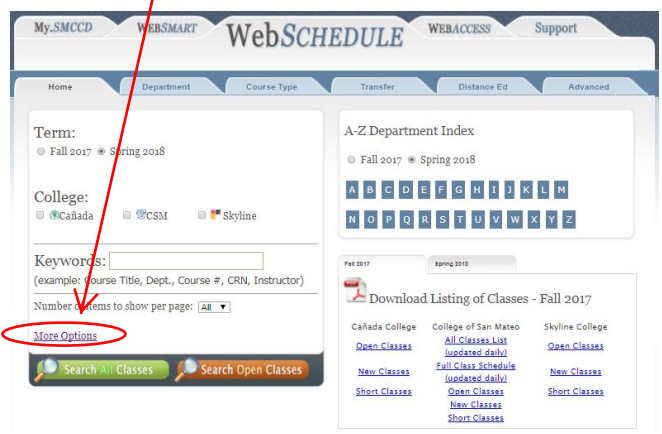

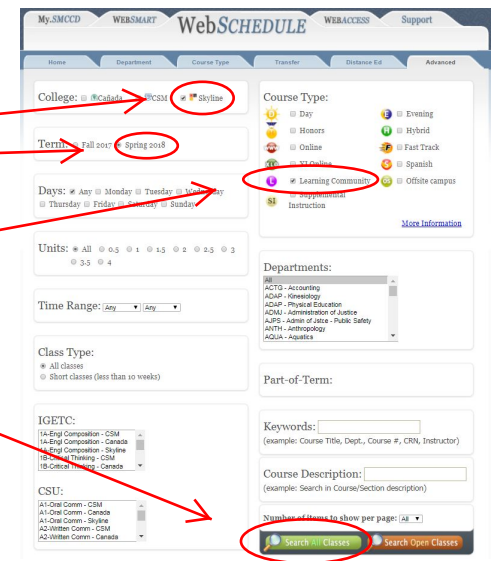
