Skyline builds a world-wide reputation

Skyline makes international connections in a number of ways. One of those is through our Center for International Trade Development (CITD), funded by a state Economic Development grant. In October, 2006, Skyline's CITD won a contract with one of the largest and oldest financial institutions in Africa, the only African Bank with offices in the USA: United Bank of Africa. Of the several competitive proposals received Skyline CITD was chosen mostly due to the quality of our proposal, the understanding of both the US and African market environment as well as the strength of our references. The grant's purpose was to develop and implement a marketing strategy and trade mission on their behalf. The Trade Mission/Road Show took place November, 16-18, 2006. The Trade Mission was a sell-out. It visited three cities and generated a lot of interest in both the CITD and Skyline College. As a direct outcome of this Trade Mission, the CITD has received additional requests from other financial institutions across Africa. Throughout the event, Skyline College was prominently featured to further expose the college to international audiences.
