Mission Statement: To empower and transform a global community of learners

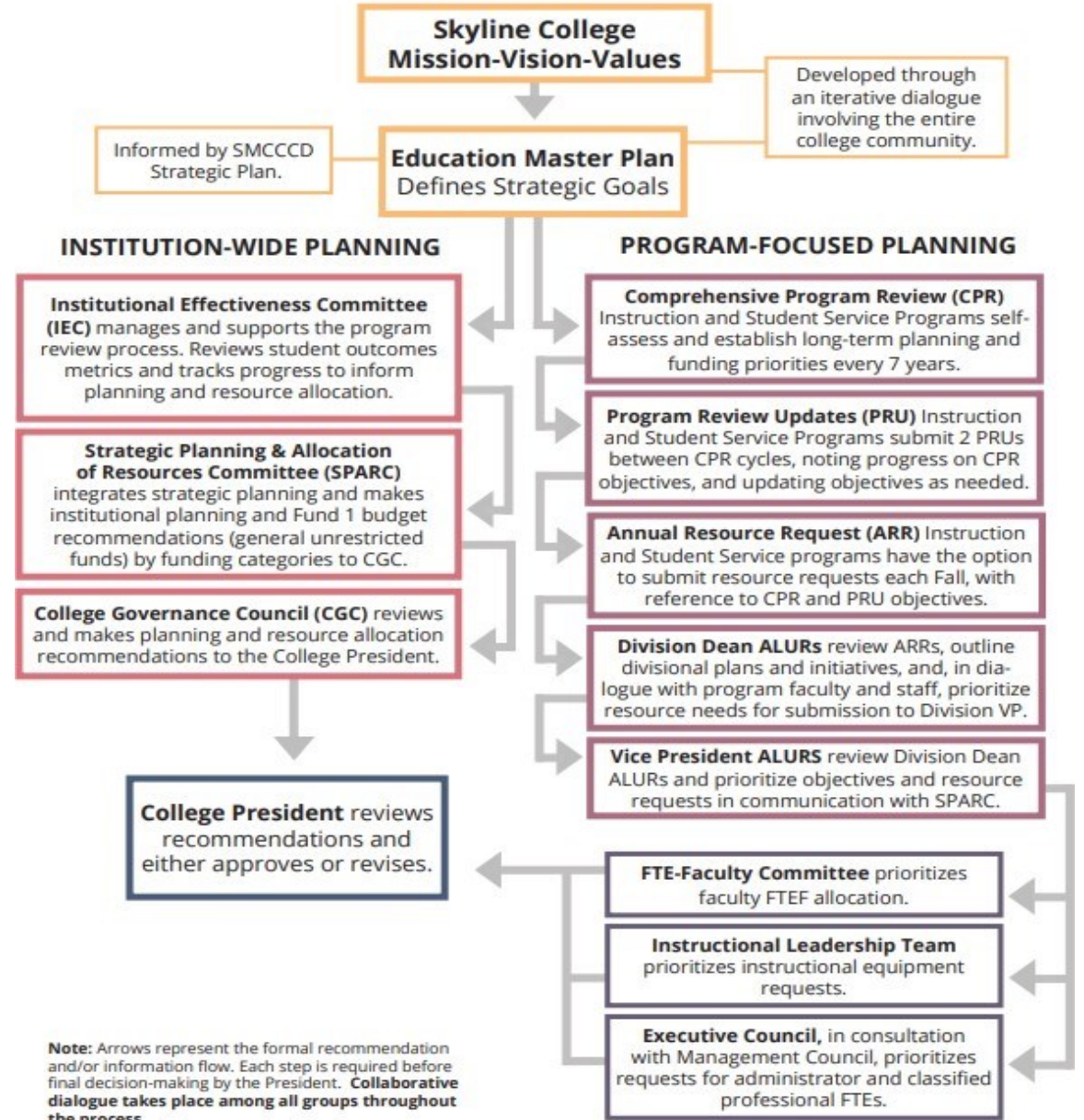
Vision Statement: Skyline College inspires a global and diverse community of learners to achieve intellectual, cultural, social, economic and personal fulfillment.

Proposed M-V-V Review Cycle

- The M-V-V will be reviewed at the start of each Education Master Planning Cycle (i.e., every 5 years).
- Significant changes or developments in the following areas may necessitate an off-cycle review: legislation and/or regulations impacting the college, accreditation, changes to CCCCO's and/or SMCCCD's mission, and/or significant changes related to college organization and/or initiatives.

Proposed Procedure for M-V-V Review and Approval

- 1) The Office of Planning, Research, Innovation and Effectiveness is charged with bringing the M-V-V to SPARC for discussion.
- 2) SPARC members will review M-V-V with constituent groups.
- 3) SPARC will further discuss and vote on recommendation on M-V-V to College Governance College (CGC).
- 4) CGC will review in a first and second read, and vote on whether the College adopt it.
- 5) If approved by the CGC, the M-V-V will go forward to the Board of Trustees for review and approval.

Next Steps for SPARC

- 1) By May 9th SPARC meeting, solicit feedback on the proposed procedure for review and approval of M-V-V from constituents.
- 2) On May 9th, SPARC votes on recommendation to CGC on proposed procedure.
- 3) If approved, the recommendation will go to the May 22nd CGC meeting for consideration to adopt.
