80% of TRiO students will demonstrate initiative and individual responsibility to persist from one academic year to the beginning of the next academic year

RESULT: 99% (310/313) of the students persisted (source: 2013-14 APR Report)

The Persistence Rate for a 2-year institutions is the percentage of all participants served in the reporting year who enroll at the grantee institution in the fall term of the next academic year or graduate with an associate's degree or receive a certificate and/or transfer from a 2-year to a 4-year institution by the fall term of the next academic year.

Note: The Actual Persistence Rate is calculated based on the greater of the number of participants funded to serve or the number of participants served.
