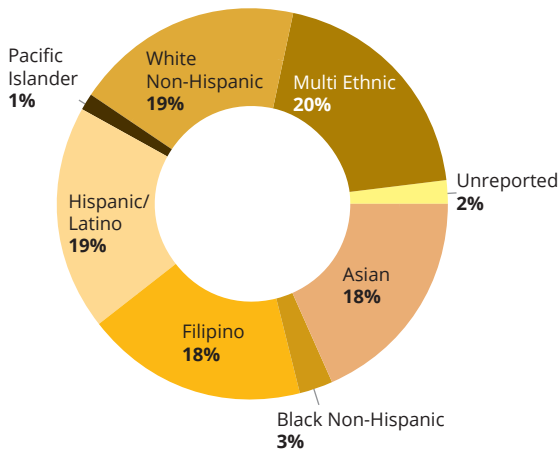

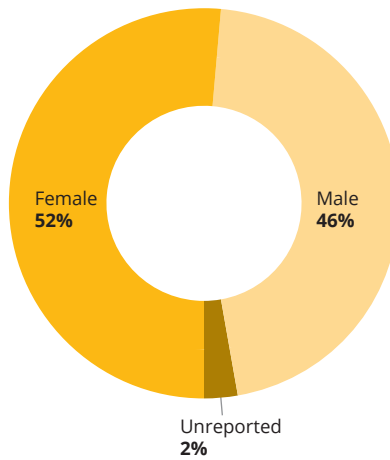

## FALL 2017 STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

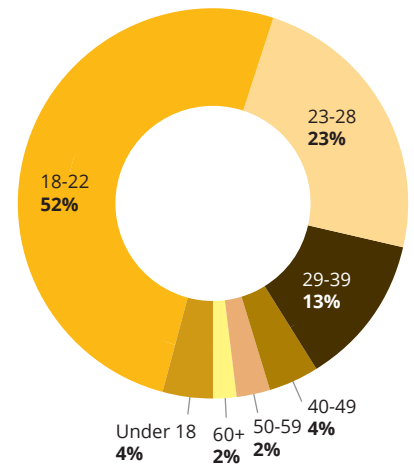
### ETHNICITY



### GENDER

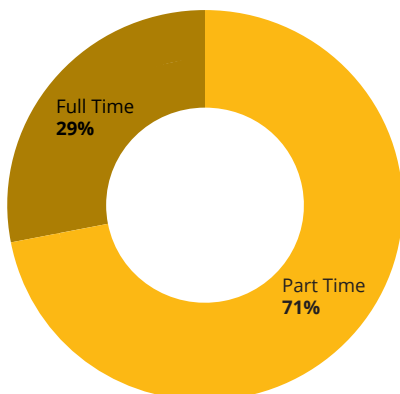


### AGE
