# What is the Online Education Initiative?

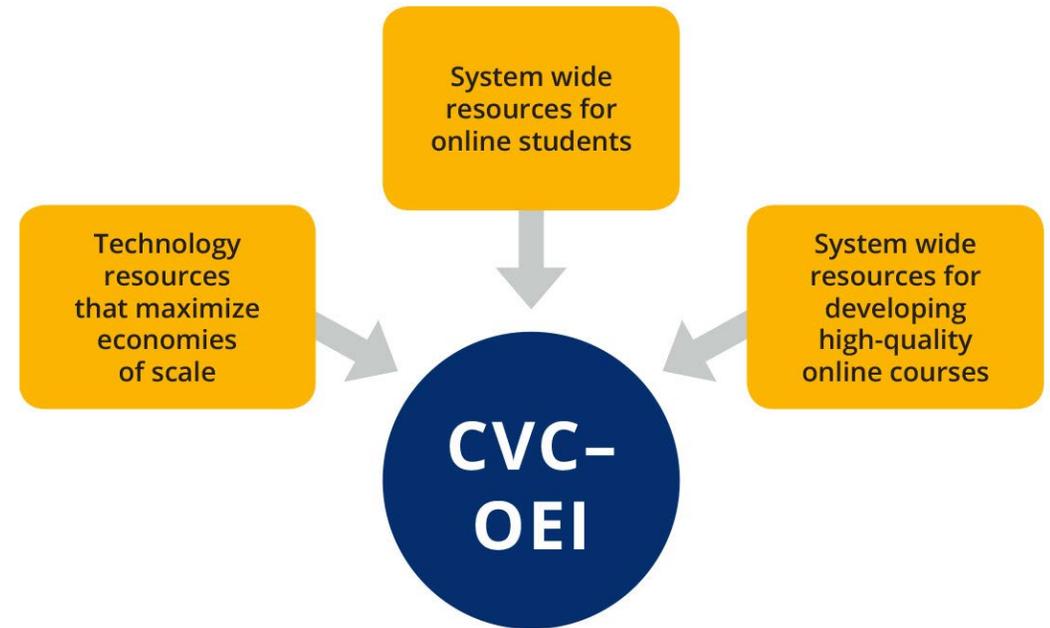
The California Virtual Campus – Online Education Initiative (CVC-OEI) is a collaborative effort among California Community Colleges (CCCs) to ensure that significantly more students can complete their educational goals by increasing both access to and success in high-quality online courses.

There are three prime components of the OEI consortium:

1. Access to online-based teaching & learning technology
2. Professional development resources
3. Student resources

~~It is the goal of the OEI to run a CCC course exchange, where students could take online courses away from their home institution if the course was unavailable at their home and there were openings at a partner school. This exchange is in development.~~

Due to COVID-19, the CCC is providing emergency technological support to all campuses. This support will expire December 31, 2020, and non-OEI campuses will not continue to receive the technology support.

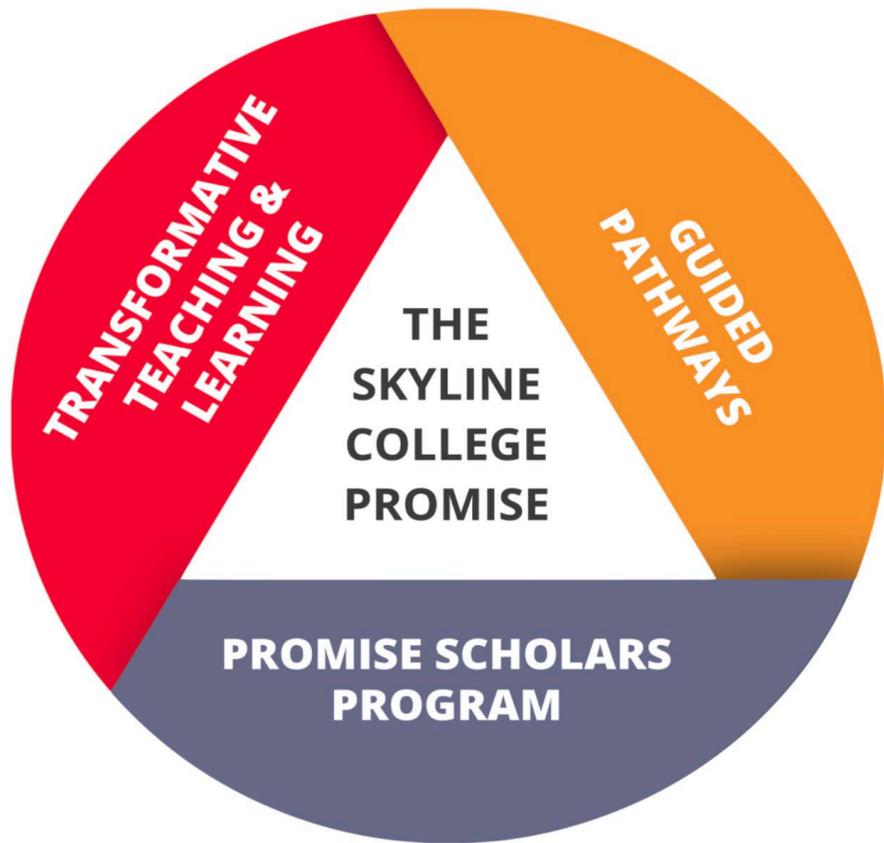

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## Timeline for Application

We would like to know technology support is available for Spring 2021 courses; therefore our goal is to submit our application materials as soon as possible. Ideally all district campuses ready to participate would submit by Veteran's Day, 2020.

*Note – Applications are taken first-come, first-serve at this point in the OEI. Our goal is to be at the front of the pack of remaining campuses in the state.*

**March 3:** Conversation with constituents responsible for OEI membership

**March 9:** Afternoon visit to Skyline College from Jory Hadsell (Executive Director of CVC-OEI) and Andrea Hanstein (Director of Communications & Strategic Partnerships)

~~**April:** Work to create resolutions at each individual campus; complete campus self-assessments, turn in as district.~~

**October 1:** Conversation with Academic Senate

October 22: Vote on resolution of support for CVC-OEI Membership



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## Prepared for All Outcomes
