Frontline Implementation Timeline

Below is a timeline for implementing the use of Frontline PD for managing, planning, implementing and reporting of faculty and classified staff professional development. The software was acquired during Summer 2017. Per department discussions, the plan is to have a CTTL Program Services Coordinator (pending approval of a permanent PSC position) manage and provide training associated with the software. In the meantime, CTTL staff have been working with Frontline software support to advance the implementation of the software, and tailor the program to Skyline College.

Summer 2017

Kick-off /Visioning Meeting: Gerard Renner from Frontline lead a web conference demonstrating the software and providing ideas for configuration.

Fall 2017

Configuration of users and forms: In order to use the software, all forms and all users needed to be loaded and configured with the correct settings. This is an iterative process that requires some debugging and setup of the users under their corresponding divisions, as well as routing the forms through the correct approval queues. The goal is to convert the application process for Article 13 support for professional develop from paper to electronic (this will reduce paper consumption and streamline the approval process).

Configuration of users and forms: — Continued
