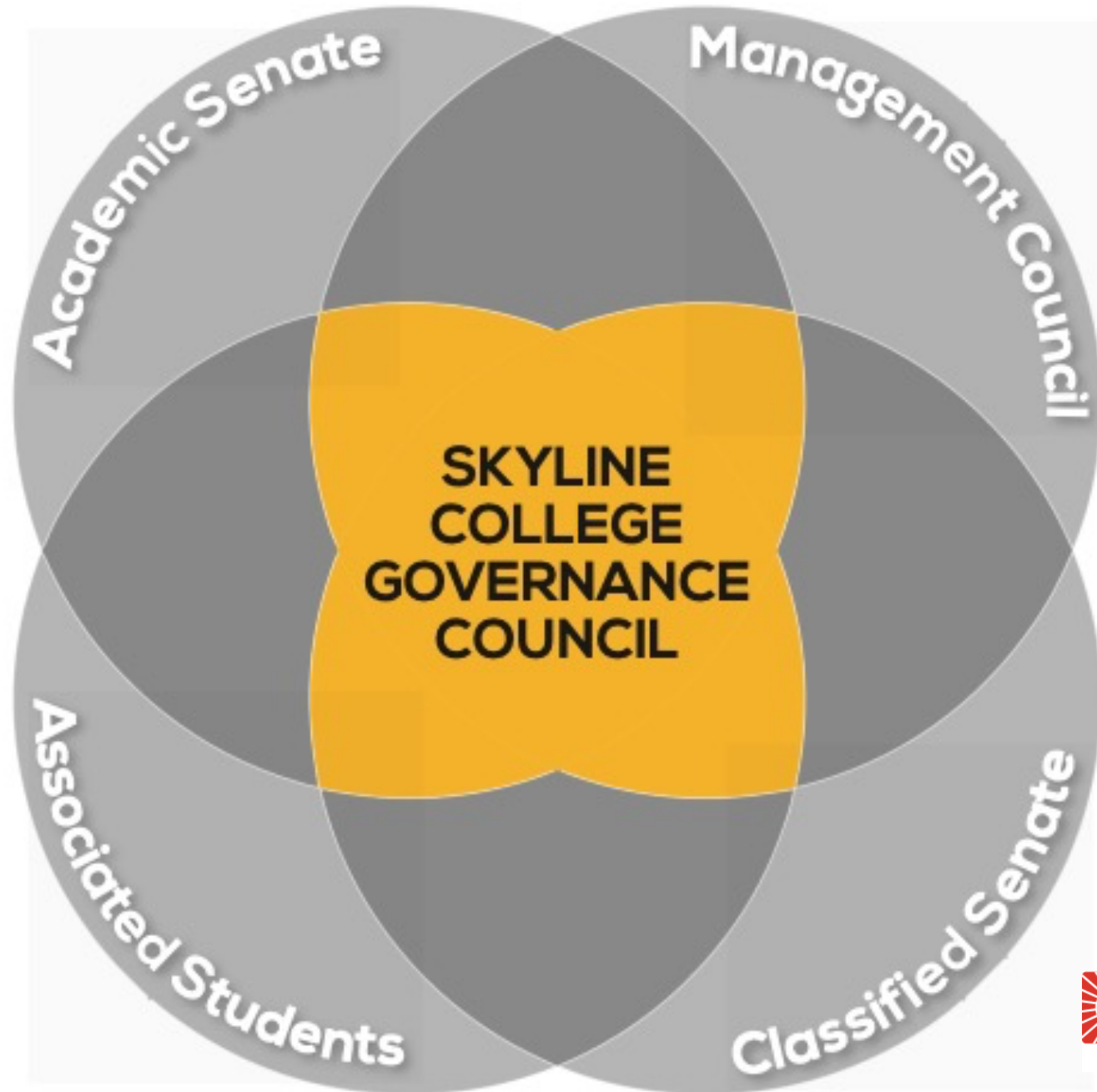

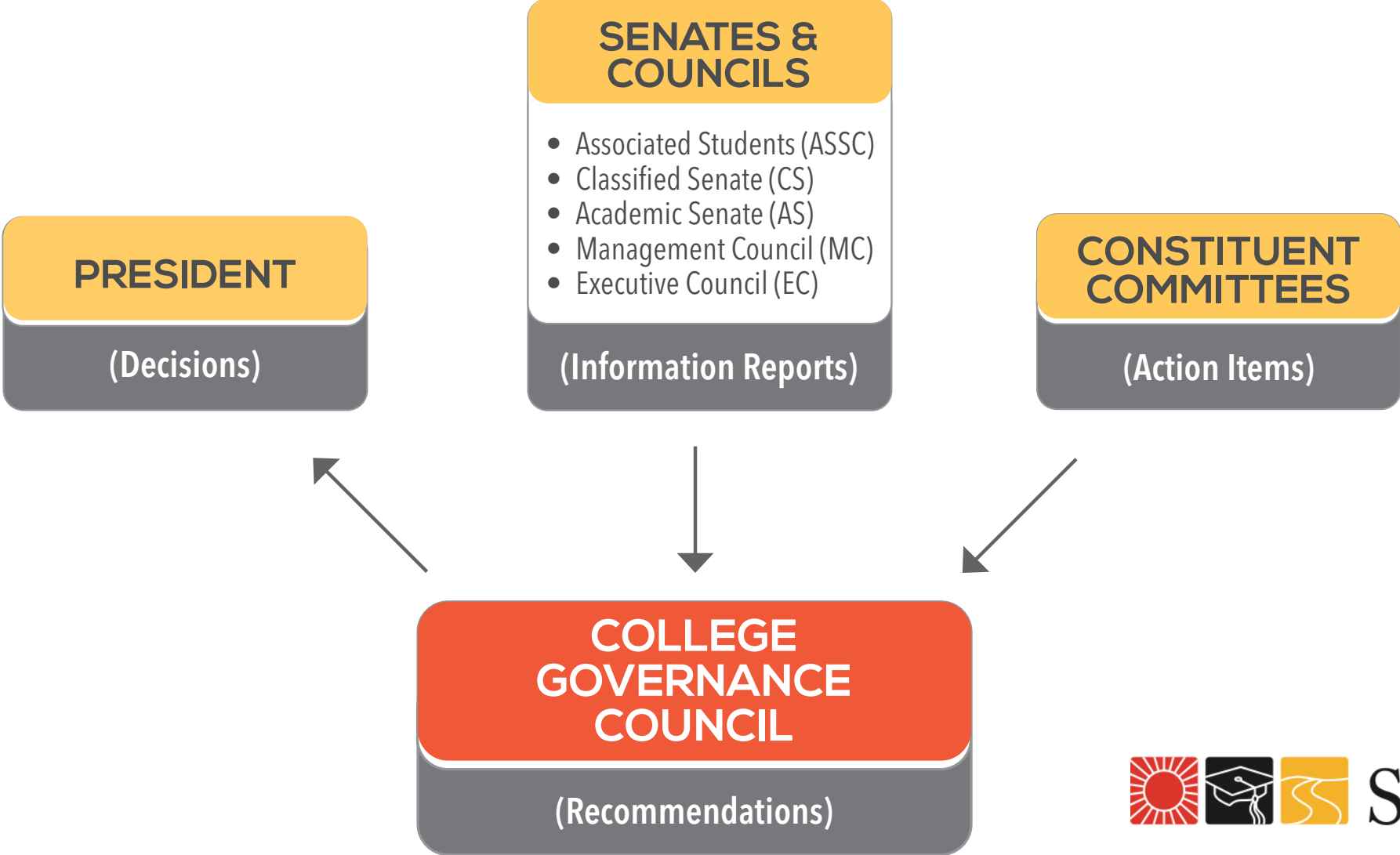

Definitions



Constituent Committee

- A constituent committee is a governance body composed of representatives from the four constituent groups*, delegated by CGC to consider, investigate, recommend, or report on College-wide matters.

*Associated Students, Academic Senate, Classified Senate, Management Council

Definitions



Senate/Council

- An elected, appointed, or ex-officio governance body that recommends, advocates for, and addresses matters of interest to their members in alignment with the College Mission, Vision and Values. (CGC, Academic Senate, ASSC, Classified Senate, Management Council, Executive Council)

Standing Committee

- A sub-committee of a Senate or Council created to focus on specific matters.

Definitions

Operational Work Group

- A non-governance group created and led by the President or a VP (or designee) that carries out an ongoing function or institutional need.

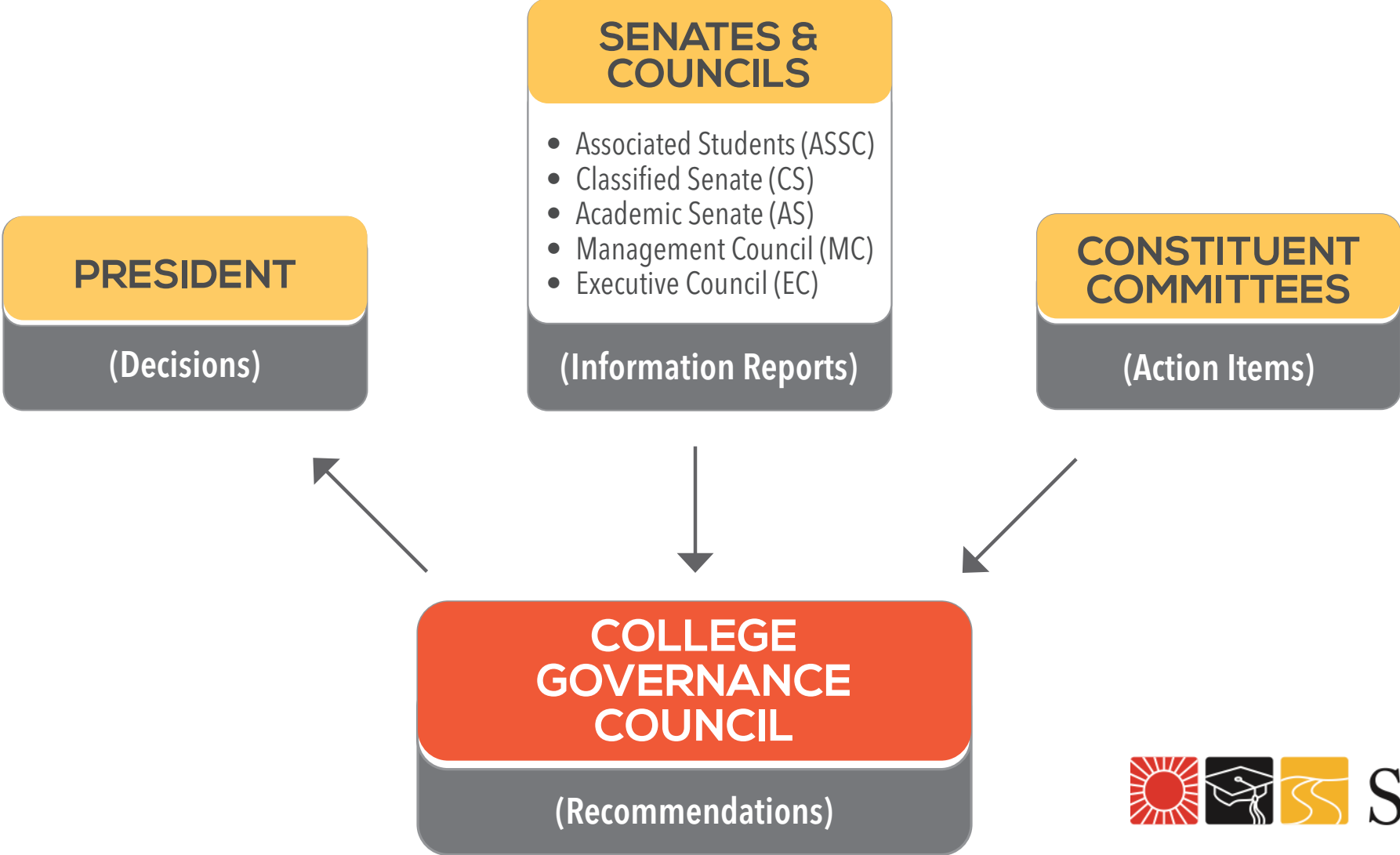

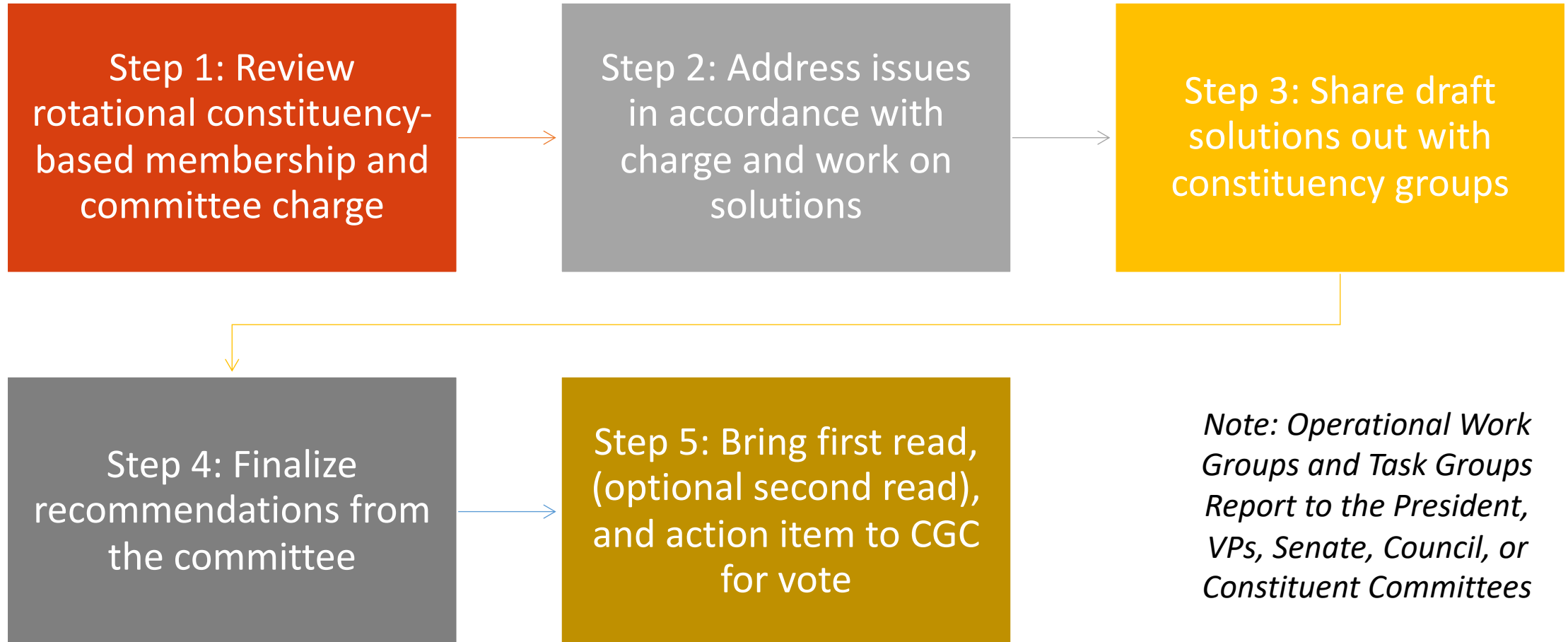
Task Group

- A short-term group created and charged by a Constituent Committee or Council/Senate, that carries out a specific task. Task Group members are approved by constituent groups. (Task Groups are not listed in the Compendium.)
