Roger Perez Vaughn and Lucia Lachmeyer from the SEED committee came to share the Student Equity Plan and elicit feedback from senate and from faculty constituents. They asked that feedback be sent by November 1<sup>st</sup>. Student Equity Plan Draft The presentation included information about the scope of the draft to be sent to the state as well as a local version that is more detailed and inclusive. Some discussion followed the presentation that included questions about specific populations not included in the plan as well as how the intersectionality of various populations might not be represented in the plan. It was explained that due to the limited scope of what the state allows in the report, this type of detailed information is not included but would be considered for our individual campus plan.

The initial discussion focused on AB928 and the impact that it may have on some programs that fall into the Lifelong Learning area. A motion to extend time was made by Secretary Truglio and was seconded by Senator Beltran. Further discussion was had regarding supporting adjunct faculty and their participation in participatory governance and campus leadership. A motion to approve the goals was made by Senator Karve and was seconded by Senator McCarthy pending grammatical edits. The goals were approved by a vote was with 16 in favor and 1 abstention no objections.

A discussion was led by Ed Policy and Co-Chair Hurless and Jacquie Escobar regarding the history and current state of the Ed Policy committee. A <u>letter</u> was ready from Past President LeighAnn Shaw regarding her opinions and experience serving on this committee as well. The discussion focused on the challenges of the committee due to the structure, limitations and redundancies. Skyline college is the only college in the district that has this committee. Ed Policy and Curriculum Co-Chair Hurless asked that Academic Senate consider making a recommendation to college governance council to make the Educational Policy committee a constituent committee. A motion to extend time was made by Secretary Truglio and was seconded by Senator Beltran. A motion was made by President Ayotte to disband the Educational Policy Committee effective at the end of Fall 2022 with the goal of reimagining the responsibility of educational procedures. Further discussion was then had regarding the need to clarify the reimagined role prior to disbanding. President Ayotte redacted her motion and made a motion to table this item for the next meeting. Treasurer Maloney seconded that motion and a vote was taken with 15 in favor, no opposition 2 abstentions. The motion to table this item passed. A task group was formed including Vice President Ryan White, Senator Cross and President Ayotte. Senator Rottenberg suggested reaching out to LeighAnne Shaw as well.
