#### **Tentative Fund 1 Budget**

- Barbara to present on tentative Fund 1 budget:
  - As of 04/27, the SMCCD Resource Allocation shows a balance budget for FY 21/22. Revenues and expenditures will continue to be updated until the final budget is adopted in the FALL
  - COLA adjustments are happening now (Classified got their April payroll, faculty next pay roll)
- 765, 544 (new estimate to present to board)
  - Consumer Price Index (the cost of everything going up increase in cost like standard/routine bills like electrical etc)
  - Spend 50% should go towards instructional
  - Board wants us to get closer to 50% bring in more full time faculty to meet that percentage (given more money to hire more faculty)
- 1.8 Mil tentative
  - Still will have 100,000+ in our budget

  - Raise money for student scholarship
  - Celebrate work we've done

# President Dr. Melissa Moreno: Recovery Plan

- Discussions on drafted plans for summer, fall, and spring
  - o leads up to a open for January 3, 2022
- Based on survey: folks are concerned to the status of vaccines of coming to campus
- health reasons and concerns of those who cannot get vaccinated (sensitive, health reasons)
  - o plan is in a form of recommendation to the board
  - District has put our safety first, and flexibility as a priority, ramp up plan to everyone coming back January 3, 2022.
  - Facilities has to be considered / health and safety
    - gradual opening

- "Champions" being a word to be re-branded:
  - Sensitivity around students about having access to vaccination
- Conversation with district cabinet of what their presence looks like in the Fall
  - o People feeling unsafe regarding anti-Asian hate in bay area
  - Working behind the scenes to bring 15% of Fall, campus will not be fully population in Fall
- If district requires vaccine before coming to campus, HR will handle this.
  - HR will need to track vaccine proof of employments, looking into laws and applying them into accommodation.
  - Campus is not yet open to the public
- Hybrid schedules:
  - How do we meet students where they are to be able to learn remotely?
  - Employees desires and needs for flexibility
  - We may consider 4/10 schedule past summer
