

**CURRICULUM COMMITTEE  
GOALS AND PROJECTS  
2014-2015**

**1) Update Curriculum Processes**

- a) Continue to develop a Curriculum Committee professional development process that broadens the knowledge of local and state-wide curriculum issues for Curriculum Committee members.
- b) Clarify definitions and review forms in CurricUNET.
- c) Clarify the process of assigning courses to disciplines, especially cross-disciplinary or multi-disciplinary courses.
- d) Create an Honors Addendum (new form) in CurricUNET.

**2) Update Major and Degree Requirements**

- a) Continue development and submission of Skyline College transfer degrees and C-ID course submissions per Transfer Model Curriculum and Intersegmental Model Curriculum guidelines.
- b) Research and review (and include in the college catalog) a practice informing students who already hold a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited American or international college or university that they may be exempt from Skyline's local GE requirements and/or other AA/AS requirements, including the basic competency, ethnic and cultural diversity, American History, and Physical Education requirements.

**3) Promote Curriculum Integrity**

- a) Work with the Dean of Planning, Research and Institutional Effectiveness to identify the best and most consistent methodology for completing the appropriate level of scrutiny in the establishment of out of discipline prerequisites for courses in accordance with Title 5.
- b) Make changes to courses as necessary to be in compliance with state repeatability regulations.
- c) Develop an effective assessment tool for the General Education Program.
- d) Develop thematic course pathways for the General Education Program.
- e) Develop a process to assign courses to disciplines.

**4) Accreditation**

- a) Annual review and update of Curriculum Handbook.
- b) Promote the Curriculum Handbook to faculty as a tool for curriculum development.

**5) Comprehensive Program Review**

- a) Perform initial assessment of how the new Comprehensive Program Review instrument is working.
- b) Work with Student Services to establish a Comprehensive Program Review instrument for Student Services departments.

**6) Baccalaureate Degrees**

- a) Explore and discuss the opportunities for Skyline College to offer a Baccalaureate degree.
