
Upcoming Changes: 2019-2020 Federal Work-Study (FWS) Program

The Federal Work-Study (FWS) program will be implementing a new process in the upcoming 2019-2020 academic year.

This change will apply to all FWS students (new and continuing).

2018-2019 Process

Currently, students interested in the program must complete their financial aid file prior to adding their name on the waitlist in the financial aid office. This process was on a first-come, first-serve basis.

2019-2020 Process

With the new process, all students must:

- Complete **and** answer 'Yes' to "If you are interested in being considered for work-study" on the 2019-2020 FAFSA
- Students must also meet the following requirements to participate in the FWS program:
 - Maintain Good Academic Standing
 - Meet Student Academic Progress
 - Cumulative 2.0 GPA **and** Cumulative 67% pace rate
 - Complete all unsatisfied student requirements by April 30, 2019
- Must 'accept' or 'deny' the FWS offer when they receive the 'Offer Notification' email
- Must attend the **mandatory** FWS Orientation
