



# Skyline College has seen a student headcount decline every year since 2013

Student Headcounts at SMCCCD Colleges



Until recently, CSMs enrollment decline had been tempered by growing international student enrollments.

## Fall 2018 to Fall 2019 Declines:

Skyline headcount is down **3.9%**

CSM headcount is down **10.7%**

Cañada headcount is down **2.7%**

**Overall, the District is down 7.7%**

FTES Declines:


Skyline FTES is down 3.0%


