




#### Q1. How many times have you served on an IEC CPR team?









Q3. Degree to which "Time to become familiar with the program via their past program reviews and goals" helped you to support the program undergoing CPR.












Q6. Degree to which "Review of the Calendar, highlighting key dates such as the consultations" helped you to support the program undergoing CPR.



### Q7. Degree to which "Last spring's IEC Orientation for programs undergoing CPR" helped you to support the program undergoing CPR.





Q8. Degree to which "Feedback on the CPR with the CPR checklist" helped you to support the program undergoing CPR.




## Q9. Other activities that helped you to support programs undergoing CPR

- (Recommendation) Vary training by experience (i.e., seasoned IEC members not required to attend Onboarding session)







#### Q12. Degree to which you agree with the following statement: The second fall consultation on program goals was productive.




Q13. Degree to which you agree with the following statement: The tone of the consultations was collegial.




Q14. Degree to which you agree with the following statement: The CPR consultations have deepened my understanding of CPR for my own program.
