

- ✓ Fall onboarding for new IEC members that highlights program review processes
- ✓ Time to become familiar with a program via past program reviews and goals
- ✓ Time to review program data
- ✓ Workshop on program goals
- ✓ Review of the calendar, highlighting key dates like the consultations
- ✓ Spring IEC CPR Orientation for new cohorts
- ✓ Feedback on the CPR with the CPR checklist

## Takeaways and Planned Changes



#### **CPR programs:**

- Allow CPR programs to opt out of consultations so we can "re-allocate" members to other programs who are interested in collegial support
- Reinforce norms for programs to be prepared for the consultation, including the flexibility of scheduling a time outside of the IEC

### **IEC** members:

- Engage CPR expertise
- Allow IEC members to opt out of CPR trainings in which they feel sufficiently expert
