1. GENERAL FUNCTIONS

1.1. Call to Order

2. ACTION ITEM(S)

2.1. Approve Agenda

3. DISCUSSION/REPORT

3.1. Feedback on the Community Engagement ISLO

Michael Cross and Andrea Fuentes facilitated a discussion about the draft ISLO, asking members to highlight major takeaways during their discussions and/or their own feedback. Following are some of the concerns that were raised in the discussion and/or written feedback:

- Are these descriptors too ambitious for our students? Are we setting them up for failure?
- Is the language of the descriptors too abstract for our students to understand?
- How are the ISLOs assessed? Can these competencies be assessed/ observed?
- Can the number of descriptors be decreased, with related ones combined?
- "Humility" raises questions of positionality; it implies that someone already has privilege and/or has a problem. Is the notion of "humility" a buzz-word of the moment? Will students understand it? Is this descriptor's intent already represented in the "Social Perspectives" descriptor?

- “Taking Future Actions” descriptor is too vague.
- “Power Dynamics” descriptor is too narrowly focused on equity and equality; power dynamics manifest in different ways
- “Interconnectedness” is too vague; what about “connections” or “relationships”?
- Should “Ethics” be “morals” instead? Should “ethics” be connected with “student agency”?
