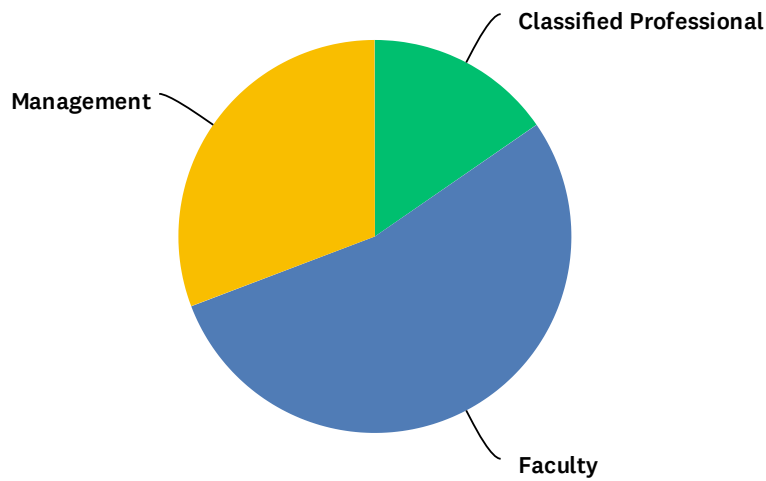


Q1 What is your primary role at the College?

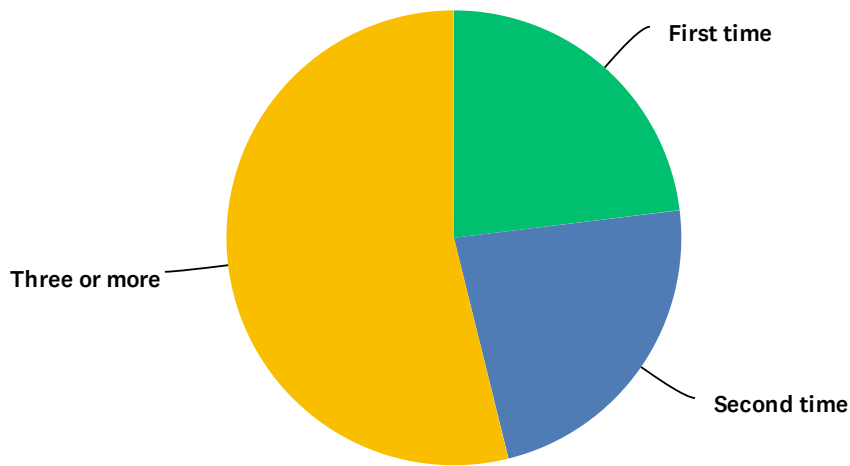

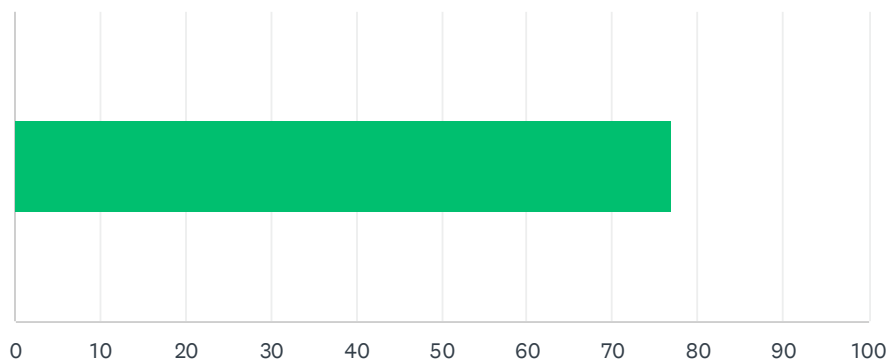
Q2 How many times have you served on IEC?

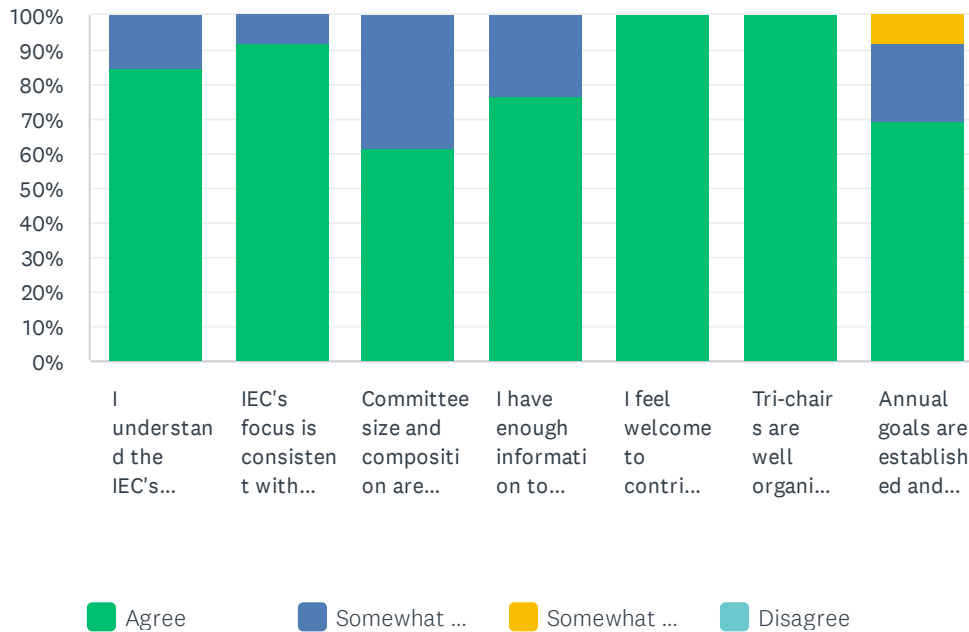

We have some very high level discussions and there's the front-line deliverable items and I can't see how the two are connected.
