

Why are we meeting?

- I am accountable to you, Skyline College, and our Campus Community
- I am hearing the campus need for greater communication about our return
- This is an act of the *People's College Initiative* in an effort to improve our climate by offering openness and transparency

Post *Shelter-In-Place* Student Picture

- 20% decline in enrollments
- A nearly 10 point decline in our full-time students (from 28% to 19%)

Students First Approach to Recovery

- We built a robust in-person schedule alongside a robust online schedule
- Marketing strategy for Spring '22
- Let's see what students do – they tend to vote with their feet – and let that guide us for Fall, 2022 (We are engaged in an iterative process)

Return to Work *Looks Different*

- Greater Flexibility than Pre-COVID
 - Details yet to come from District HR
 - *Student-centric approach*
 - Likely the majority of days per week are required to be in-person
- If you're feeling sick, stay home – applies to both students and employees
- Flexibility and grace

Vaccine Update - Employees

- <https://smccd.edu/return-to-campus/employees.php>
- Employees must be vaccinated (unless they receive a valid medical or religious exemption from HR).
- “Decline to State” is no longer an option

Vaccine Update - Students

- <https://smccd.edu/return-to-campus/students.php>
- Students must be vaccinated unless
 - they receive a valid medical exemption; or
 - declare to be a fully online student
- Students choosing not to attest will be considered a “fully online student” and redirected to online student services and instruction
- Student vaccination portal open 11/3/21

Ventilation Update

- The District is required to provide OSHA compliant workspaces
- All workspaces at Skyline College are OSHA compliant, including “Legacy Buildings such as SKY B19 (Pac Heights) and SKY B1
- And we are going above and beyond
