## 4.1. Education Master Planning: Plan for April 21 Flex Day

## 4.2. Education Master Planning: Complete First Draft of Goals

Members revisited draft goals and discussed comments made on the shared <u>Google Doc</u>. Notes on individual goals are below:

Goal 1: Should the first goal listed be more student-focused, rather than numbers-focused?

<u>Goal 2</u>: Members discussed the term "obligation gap," and whether it is the appropriate term for the goal. Will the college community be aware of the definition of the term? Is "equity-gap" better? <u>Goal 3</u>: No notes.

<u>Goal 4</u>: Members debated the use of the word "healthy." Are there too many definitions of "healthy?" Other suggestions included "collegial," "positive," "constructive," "transformative," and "beneficial."

<u>Goal 5</u>: Would "foster" be a better word than "create?" Does "create" imply that we don't already have an antiracist and equitable culture?

<u>Goals 6</u>: The structure of the goal does not match the structure of the other goals. Does the definition of "civic literacy" need more clarity?



<u>Goal 7</u>: A new goal suggested by Dr. Moreno. Members recommended that it could be a kind of "headliner" or "catchall" goal, encompassing several broad ideas. Could it be used in the preamble? Members went into breakout rooms to discuss the goals in smaller groups for about fifteen minutes. Members reconvened to report on individual discussions.
