 - VPSS Update: The college previously received \$115,000 per college, but funding has now been reduced to \$30,000 total for the college due to decreased state grants.
 - ASSC Discussion: As representatives, we aim to support and minimize the impact on students; however, potential effects may include reductions in student employment opportunities.
 - Student assistant hours may be cut in the worst-case scenario.
 - Danny(Commissioner of Activities) noted this situation has already occurred at the Learning Center.
