- 1. Alvin Gubatina
 - a. Reminder to set a bi weekly meeting with Alvin
- 2. Ryan Samn Situation in Myanmar 2021
 - a. A lot of the (international) students from Myanmar and their families/communities are in distress because there is a civil war
 - b. Affects Skyline College because they cut off phone + data lines, networks, and WiFi at Myanmar
 - Burmese students/individuals cannot text and communicate with their families
 - ii. Skyline College students in Myanmar cannot log into online classes
 - 1. Bank accounts are also cut
 - iii. Alvin sent information about this issue to President Moreno, but did not hear back from her yet
 - c. Alvin: Update that 5 Burmese students are in Myanmar, 14
 Burmese students in U.S. sent information about how it affects
 them as students
 - i. Communication to professors about this, will send to counselors about providing mental health services
 - d. Minn's thoughts: On Feb. 1, the military took over the phone lines and television use (some students still have some WiFi, but that can be cut out anytime)
 - Wants to raise this issue throughout campus (and campus) to further support Burmese students
 - ii. We can make an event (Alvin, Ryan, Minn can coordinate) or do more to address this problem

- iii. Minn can send his letter to Jade (student trustee) and/or DSC meeting at Fri. 2/5 @ 2pm
 - Better for the campus/district to do something about it
- iv. We can do a fundraiser, but we need to think about fundraising logistics and our commitments

 - i. Integrated student success system
