#### VI. Reports

#### 1. Advisor Reports

#### a. Alvin

Alvin announces that there will be a celebration at Canada College on Thursday, 9/22 from 10am - 12:15pm for a press conference and full lunch. The event is for undocumented residents and community college students. Senator Josh Becker wrote SB 893 for free community college for SMCCD. Alvin asked which students wanted to attend. Jonathan, Iliana, Irah, and Jerry will attend.

Alvin also mentions there will be a Student Senate of California Community College (SSCCC) 2-day conference on Friday 9/30 and Saturday 10/1 at the Westin SFO. The virtual event is free and the in-person event is \$300 per student. Win, Anthony, and Iliana will attend. If any other students would like to attend, let Alvin know by the end of the day.

#### b. Ryan

Ryan reports that the Latinx Heritage Month film screening for "La Mission" will be held in this meeting room this coming Thursday 9/22 from 1:30 pm-3:30pm. 40 students from Middle College will be in attendance and Martin Marquez will be giving an opening statement at the event.

#### 2. Student Trustee

Lesly talks about SB893 and the event happening on Thursday as discussed in Alvin's report. She also speaks about Policy 2.18 that regards Student Participation in Participatory Government. This policy will pay the students who are volunteering their time \$25/hr for committee meetings. Additionally, she speaks about vaccination requirements and how the Chancellor will create a group to review vaccination policies and booster requirements.
