- 1. <u>Curriculum Update: DE Addenda, Labs</u>
 All classes offered online. Lab classes still available Face to Face with restrictions: 2 classrooms of 10 students each with separate instructors.
- 2. Accreditation Update:
- A. Program Annual Report Delayed. Interruptions to clinical training delayed 2020 cohort placements, as well as to the 2021 cohort. No data available to write report. ARC-STSA postponed due dates for Reports until next year.
- B. Certification Exam Delayed. Students unable to complete program were not eligible to take exam. National Board will still honor applications for exams even over 1 year.
- 3. Staffing Update:
- A. Instructional Aide- due to pandemic, Mary McKay took full-time position at Surgery Center, reducing availability.

- B. Clinical Coordinator- Monica Franciosa found this position challenging. Informed Director she was taking Medical Leave. CC Duties have been assigned to Program Director
- 4. Cohort Update:
- A. Class of 2020- 23 Admitted, 17 retained. Labs were provided to refresh skills in preparation for placements.

Placements: 7 were placed by March, however hospitals cancelled them due to pandemic. 5 have returned to their sites. 2 more have been placed. As of 12/11, three have completed their training.
